OUR PHILOSOPHY

We wish to honor God by providing an education that recognizes Him as the Creator and Lord. It is our goal to produce full time Christians. We want to produce young men and women who serve the Lord Jesus Christ at home, at work, and in their local church. Psalm 92.13 says, "Those that be planted in the house of the LORD shall flourish in the courts of our God." We believe that the Church school acts as a "greenhouse." We want to educate them while "in the house of the LORD," so that they may flourish. We seek students who are in agreement with our purpose and philosophy. Since we are an independent Baptist Church, it is our policy to accept only students who attend an independent Baptist Church.

OUR ROLE

We realize that the school is but one part in the life and development of a child. The home and church are vital. It is almost impossible for the school to be effective if the home is not supportive, and the church is not honored. For this reason, it is one of our requirements that all students attend at least 3 out of the 4 services their local church provides each week. Not only that, but we expect this to continue throughout the summer months, when school is not in session.

SUMMARY OF DOCTRINAL STATEMENT

1. We believe in the Scriptures of the Old and New testaments. We believe in the verbal, plenary inspiration of Scripture, and in the inerrancy of God's Word. The Bible is the supreme and final authority in all matters of faith, life and practice. Only any student or faculty member will use the King James Bible.
2. We believe in one God, eternally existent in three Persons: The Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.
3. We believe in the virgin birth of Jesus Christ, His sinless life, vicarious death, bodily resurrection, literal return and absolute Deity.
4. We believe that man was created in the image of God; that Adam was the first man, and not just a "type" of mankind. We believe that he sinned, became a sinner, and that the sin nature has been passed on to all men.
5. We believe in a literal Hell, and those men who do not accept Jesus Christ as their Savior will spend eternity in Hell.
